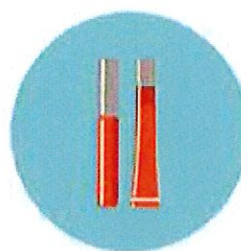
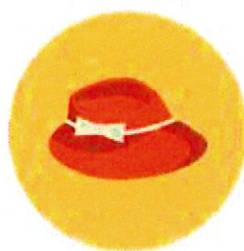
### Forest School
