

Appointment KS1 & EYFS Class Teacher at Filleigh Community Primary School

Filleigh Community Primary School is in the village of Filleigh which is located on the old A361 between South Molton and Barnstaple. The School is part of the Devon Moors Federation, a successful, established six school maintained federation which includes Chittlehampton Church of England (VA) Primary School, Copplestone Primary School, Kilmington Primary School, Shute Primary School and Spreyton Primary School. Filleigh and Chittlehampton schools federated in April 2010, the federation expanded in May 2014 to include Copplestone and Spreyton Schools and again in February 2021 to include Kilmington and Shute Schools. We are also part of the United Schools Learning Partnership Co-Operative Trust which we joined in February 2018

Filleigh is a small school set in stunning rural surroundings with a building comprising 3 classrooms, an art/store room, a PPA room, a library, staffroom and office. We are fortunate to have a good sized playing field and an extensive environmental area. An excellent village hall is situated behind the school and this is used for curricular and extra curricular activities.

The school has 79 pupils at present taught in a KS1/FSU class (split across 2 classrooms), a Year 3/4 class and a Year 5/6 class. The age range for the school is 3 – 11 and we have a thriving pre-school. We have three full time teachers with specialist teachers covering PPA and enriching provision. The pre-school has a full time Level 3 practitioner who will work closely with the successful candidate to maximise the provision across the FSU and KS1. We have several part-time, very experienced classroom assistants who work throughout the school supporting children in a variety of ways. All adults in the school provide positive role models for the children and expect children to behave to a high standard.

First and foremost we are looking for someone who can demonstrate that they are an excellent primary school practitioner with experience of working in KS1 and the EYFS. The Executive Headteacher and Governors are committed to CPD and are keen to support candidates who wish to develop their professional practice and careers.
