We have two vacancies at Chittlehampton C of E Primary School that ideally we would like filled by the same person, however these could be split if necessary.

Post 1: Catering Position with Devon Norse

Devon Norse have a fabulous opportunity to join one of the fastest growing facilities management companies in the South West. The role will involve transporting the lunch from Filleigh Primary School over to Chittlehampton C of E Primary School and serving the children. The total hours are 6 hours 15 minutes per week (1 hour 15 minutes per day) from 11.30 - 12.45 term time only. Duties will include transporting the food, serving the children and washing up.

Post 2: Mealtime Assistant

This post can be attached to the role above so that one person covers lunch duty from 11.30am to 1.30pm 5 days per week. This role pays £9.00 per hour for 38 weeks per year (term time only) and as with Post 1 salaries are pro-rated to be paid over the 12 month period.

Duties for this role will include supervising and assisting children in their play once they have finished eating. If the same person undertakes both posts then these will run on from Post 1.
